



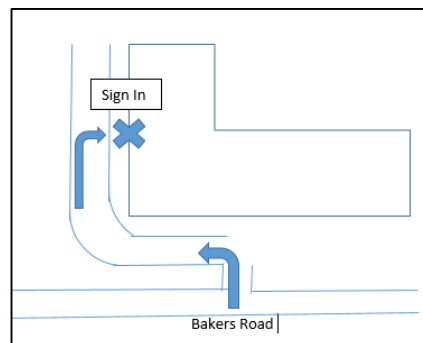
## Here are a few IMPORTANT last minute reminders for the Production.

### Student Information

- On the night of their performance students are to **arrive at the Christine Strachan Theatre, South Oakleigh College, Bakers Road Oakleigh South between 5:45 and 6:00pm**
- All students in the performance are to be signed in at the door marked 'Stage Door' to the left of the main building as you come in off Bakers Road (see map to the right). They will then be escorted to the change room backstage by CRPS Staff.
- Students are only required to attend on their designated night.
- Students should have a meal before the performance and are not to bring food or drink to the theatre, other than a named bottle of water.
- Students will need to wear something they can easily change in to and out of at the theatre e.g. track suit
- All students are to bring a named plastic bag to put their shoes, socks and clothes in when they change.
- All students (with the exception of those who have allergies to make-up products) are to have liquid foundation (skin coloured) applied to the face before coming to the theatre. A little blush and lipstick can also be applied at home if wanted.
- Students are **NOT TO WEAR** nail polish, watches or jewellery, bracelets or wrist/ankle bands.
- Students are not to bring money, electronic devices or other valuables to the performance.
- Asthma and any other medication should be clearly named and handed to the teacher in charge of First Aid on the night. This can be done at the sign in desk.



### Parent Information

- The production will finish at approximately **8.30pm**
- At the conclusion of the performance parents will be directed where to sign out their children.
- Order forms for the Production DVD and photographs will be distributed at school in Term 4.
- A sign out sheet will be in each classroom, should parents wish to collect their child after they return from the rehearsal.
- Classes and timetables will operate as normal as possible during production week.

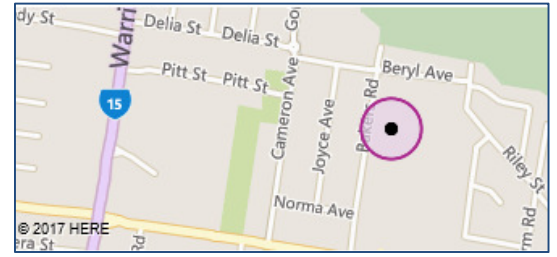

# General Information

---

## Location and Parking

The school production will be held at the Christine Strachan Theatre, South Oakleigh Secondary College, Bakers Road South Oakleigh. Onsite parking will be available and we ask you follow the instructions of those directing traffic.



## Food & Drinks

---

Tea and coffee will be available for purchase in the foyer before the performance only. Food and drink (except for bottled water), will not be permitted inside the theatre.

## Late Arrival Policy

---

We aim to begin the performance on time. To avoid distracting the audience and performers, latecomers will only be admitted to the theatre via the back doors when there is a suitable break in the program. Ushers positioned outside the doors will be available to assist you.

## Children and Babies

---

The school production is a child friendly event and we encourage children to attend however, a ticket must be purchased and a seat allocated for each child three years of age and over. Children 2 years of age and under will be admitted free of charge provided they do not occupy a seat and sit on the lap of a parent or guardian.

## Prams

---

Due to fire regulations, prams cannot be taken into the theatre. Pram parking will be available in a clearly sign-posted area in the foyer.

## Conditions of Entry

---

For the safety of all patrons, it is a condition of entry that you follow any instructions given by Camelot Rise or South Oakleigh College staff.

## Inside the Theatre Reminders

---

- All patrons must have a valid ticket for entry into the theatre and must sit in a designated seat during the performance
- Sitting or standing in the aisles or access ways is not permitted at any time during the performance
- To ensure an enjoyable experience for all visitors and no distractions for our performers, we ask all patrons to ensure they turn off or mute all mobile phones and other electronic devices before entering the theatre.
- The venue is smoke free – this includes E-cigarettes

**The use of cameras, video cameras and other recording devices is NOT permitted during performances.**
